TIPS FOR SUCCESS

The Academy team is here to support you. Here are some tips we know will help you make the most of your Academy time.

- Come to class on time, work to the best of your abilities, and approach your Academy class as an academic priority.
- Attendance affects your success. Come to class every day; and if you need to be absent, make sure your attendance is updated.
 Touch base with your teacher when you're absent to find out what work needs to be made up.
- Use a reminder on your phone or computer to get to your shuttle on time. Talk to your base school teacher about your Academy class to coordinate your departures and arrivals. This small adjustment will quickly become an easy routine.
- Communicate! Don't hesitate to ask questions. Talk to your teacher, send us an email (contact info is on the front of this page), or visit the Academy office in FHS E119 we are here to help. It's best to find solutions to your questions when they arise.

NEED TO KNOW: ACADEMY ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES

Fairfax Academy follows FCPS attendance policies; there are some procedures that are specific to Academy. Your base school does not communicate attendance information to Fairfax Academy for absences due to illness, field trips/activities, testing, etc. It is the parent's or guardian's responsibility to communicate absences to the Academy.

- Call the Attendance line at 703-219-4060 or use the online attendance form at https://fairfaxacademy.fcps.edu/resources/attendance/attendance-form
- A parent or guardian must report absences from the email and phone number listed in SIS; students may not report their own absences even if they are over 18.
- Report absences on the day of the absence, but no more than two school days after the absence.
- Use a Pre-Arranged Absence form (on our website) for absences you know about in advance.

Arriving late for your class? Come to E119 for a pass to class. Bring a signed and dated note from a parent to excuse tardies.

Need your student to check out early? Parents must send a signed and dated note; students bring the note to E119 upon arrival. Parents may also call the Academy office at (703) 219-2226 and speak to a staff member to authorize early dismissal. Students may not leave Fairfax Academy early until we have received parent permission and the student has completed check-out in E119.

HOW WE COMMUNICATE WITH YOU



Fairfax Academy sends out a biweekly email with news, updates, upcoming events, and other information. It contains information you need! Please review your contact information to be sure that you receive those messages.

ACADEMY LANYARDS

For the safety of all students, Academy students will be required to wear an ID on a lanyard while on the Fairfax HS campus. Lanyards help us identify Academy students when arriving and departing Fairfax HS, and while students are moving around the building. It is also important to be able to identify students in case of an emergency. You must wear your lanyard at all times while you are at Fairfax Academy. If lost, the replacement cost of a lanyard and ID is \$5.



GETTING TO FAIRFAX ACADEMY

Students must select their transportation method at the beginning of the year. FCPS policy states that students cannot ride the bus on some days and drive a car on other days. You are strongly encouraged to ride a shuttle bus if one is available to you.



SHUTTLE BUSES will arrive at and leave from **DOOR 1** (this is a **CHANGE from previous years!**) at Fairfax High School. Contact your base school counselor to determine the location of the shuttle bus pickup and dropoff at your base school (or pick up a shuttle schedule at Open House on August 17). Important: Be at the bus stop 5 minutes before the scheduled time – buses run on a tight schedule and they leave promptly! If you miss your bus, your absence will be unexcused, and your parent will be responsible for getting you back to your base school.

DRIVERS must obtain a Fairfax Academy parking tag and park in Academy marked spaces near Door 10. You can request a parking tag by turning in all your forms, and bringing your completed request with documentation to E119. The cost is \$67 and the fee is waived if you have purchased a parking tag at your base school.



Want to carpool with another student? Both students need to indicate this on the transportation agreement, with parental permission. If your transportation plan changes during the year, you need to notify the Academy office.

TRANSPORTATION QUESTIONS

Absences/Tardies Due to Transportation

Absence due to a missed shuttle is an unexcused absence. When this happens, go to your base school attendance office or main office so that your school staff can contact the Academy office. This lets us know that you are safe and accounted for.

Absences and tardies related to car transportation (including unavailability of carpools, traffic delays, and car trouble) are unexcused. Have a backup plan!

When You Need Help With Transportation

Shuttles typically run on very reliable schedules. However, if your shuttle is late (at your base school or at Fairfax Academy), go to the main office or attendance office. Have one person from your school wait at the bus stop, if possible, while another student reports the late shuttle. The office staff will call transportation and help get you on your way.

NEED TO KNOW: ACADEMY SCHEDULE & INCLEMENT WEATHER

Delayed Openings & Early Releases

On a 2-hour delayed opening...

- AM and Mid-Day shuttles will not run. Drivers should remain at their base schools AM and Mid-Day.
- PM classes will be held as normal and shuttles will run on time.
- Fairfax HS students will follow the Fairfax HS altered bell schedule.
- You do not need to report absences for AM and Mid-Day classes for delayed opening days.



When FCPS releases 2 hours early (for weather and on scheduled Early Release days)...

- AM classes will be held as normal.
- Mid-Day, MD/PM double block, and PM shuttles will not run. Drivers should remain at their base schools.
- You do not need to report absences for Mid-Day, MD/PM, and PM classes on early release days.
- Sometimes testing, pep rallies, and other events change the schedule at base schools. The schedule at Fairfax Academy doesn't change (shuttle schedules remain the same). Students who are absent for these activities should use a Pre-Arranged Absence form.

FOR MIDDAY STUDENTS: LUNCH

Students in a Fairfax Academy midday class (5th or 6th period) should be aware that the shuttle departure does not typically leave time for lunch at the base school. Bring lunch with you or purchase it in the Fairfax HS cafeteria when you arrive. Your student account will be available at both schools. Fairfax HS students in midday/double-blocked classes will go to A lunch before coming to their Academy class. Students in PM classes need to eat lunch before arriving at Academy.
